Sudan's Humanitarian Aid Commission

Efforts made by the Government of Sudan to support the humanitarian situation in South Sudan

- 1/ Sudan provided 2,500 tons of sorghum, tents and food supplies by the end of 2016.
- 2/ The Government of the Sudan granted the World Food Program 10,000 sacks of sorghum to be delivered to South Sudan and distributed to those affected.
- 3/ The agreement on delivery of humanitarian assistance between the Government of Sudan represented by the Humanitarian Aid Commission and the Government of South Sudan represented by its Embassy in Khartoum, whose aim is to deliver 65,000 metric tons of humanitarian aid to the affected areas in south Sudan through the World Food Program, has been extended.
- 4/ The President of the Republic of Sudan instructed to facilitate and provide humanitarian assistance to those affected by famine in South Sudan and to open the new corridors to deliver aid.
- 5/ Presidential directives have also been issued to facilitate the transfer of humanitarian aid to South Sudan.
- 6/ The President of the Republic of Sudan donated an urgent aid package of 10,000 tons of sorghum to famine hit peoples in south Sudan.
- 7/ The Humanitarian Aid Commission, in coordination with the Sudanese Centre for Voluntary Organizations (SCOVA), launched a donation campaign for organizations and partners to provide assistance to South Sudan.
- 8/ The Government of the Sudan agreed to the World Food Program to purchase 60,000 tons of sorghum from the local market to facilitate humanitarian access to South Sudan and to support the national economy.
- 9/ The Higher Committee for the Support of Refugees from the State of South Sudan was formed by the decision of the Vice President. It includes about 40 members representing various governmental bodies, foreign and national voluntary organizations, unions, and the United Nations in addition to individuals interested in humanitarian work. The committee formed sub-committees according to different sectors with the mission to mobilize support

and humanitarian assistance to South Sudan, and coordinate aid operations between the mentioned entities.

10/ The Humanitarian Aid Commission supported a number of popular initiatives and caravans for those affected in south Sudan.

11/ The Sudanese government agreed to open a route for the United Nations to deliver humanitarian aid through:

- (El Obeid Heglig - Rabkuna – Aweil).
- (El Obeid - Al-Fulah – Aweil).
- (El Obeid- Abyei).
